Individual Tuition



Overview

Individual Tuition is designed for students who need intensive English language training and who feel that a one-to-one approach is a more effective learning method for them. It is also suitable for students who have limited time at their disposal.

Tuition

For individual tuition a tailor-made course is provided to suit the exact needs of the student. The number of private classes and the learning areas to be covered during the programme can be arranged in advance or when the student arrives at the Institute. The student discusses this in detail with the Director of Studies and the student's personal teachers.



Timetable

A tailor-made timetable can be agreed between the student and the teacher.

Levels

Individual tuition is offered at all levels from complete beginner to advanced.

Minimum Course Duration

One week.

Age Group

Individual tuition can be booked for students aged 17+.

Locations

Courses are held year-round in Palmerston Park. During the summer months, this course may be held at one of our summer centres.

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Examinations:

Students attending an individual course can prepare for the following examinations: University of Cambridge (PET, FCE, Advanced & Proficiency), TIE Examination, TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS and the Oxford Test of English (OTE). It is also possible to prepare for other examinations on request. All examinations are subject to availability and payment of the appropriate fee.

Textbooks

We use the most up-to date textbooks and teaching materials. Textbooks are not included in the course fee. Students can purchase textbooks from the school or from recommended bookstores in the city centre. Textbooks cost approximately €50. We can include the cost of a first book in your invoice on request.

Availability

Please check availability with the Institute before confirming any of our courses. Once the booking is confirmed students can begin their course on any Monday morning at 09.00 am.
