Overview

The English Plus Internship programme guarantees an initial study period at the Emerald Cultural Institute followed by an unpaid internship in a company, allowing the student to gain excellent experience not only in a chosen field but also of working in an English-speaking environment.

The Emerald cooperates with partner organisations specialised in the area of recruitment to find internship placements for students in internationally recognised companies as well as national and European organisations.

This course combines a minimum of four weeks language study with between eight weeks and six months of hands-on working experience. Our internship is an ideal option for students studying with us who want to improve future career prospects by gaining valuable experience to include on a CV.

Tuition Hours

Students must take a minimum of 4 weeks of any one of our courses.

Levels

Students are recommended to have a minimum level of Upper-intermediate (CEFR B2) to join this programme and to be able to work through English.

Minimum Course Duration

Students must take a minimum of 4 weeks English language classes at the Emerald Cultural Institute, followed by a minimum of 8 weeks internship, up to a maximum of 6 months.

Age Group

This programme is designed for students aged 18+.



The Emerald Cultural Institute requires 8 weeks notice prior to the commencement of the internship and availability of placements may vary according to the sectors. The company will decide on the work schedule of students, which could involve weekends and evenings in certain sectors.

Students are required to indicate 3 different areas they would be interested in, taking into account their education, training and future career path. We provide course participants with a range of of internship possibilities, including placements in the following sectors: Financial services, IT, Marketing, Hospitality, Food, Travel, Fashion, Retail, Media, Arts, PR, Advertising, Event Planning, Politics, Law and NGOs.

Locations

The course will be held in Palmerston Park. The internship placement will be in the greater Dublin area.

Accommodation options are available for the duration of both the course and internship, however the location of the internship cannot be guaranteed.

Testing and Placement

Students are given an online test in advance of arrival and placed in a class appropriate to their level of English. Students' progress is monitored on an ongoing basis and their class level is adjusted accordingly.

Textbooks

We use the most up-to date textbooks and teaching materials. Textbooks are not included in the course fee. Students can purchase textbooks from the school or from recommended bookstores in the city centre. Textbooks cost approximately €50. We can include the cost of a first book in your invoice on request.

Availability

Please check availability with the Institute before confirming any of our courses. Once the booking is confirmed students can begin their course on any Monday morning at 09.00am. 8 weeks notice are required prior to the commencement of the internship.

Students who would like to participate in the Internship programme must pay a once-off placement fee.
