The Examination Course is designed to prepare students for the Cambridge First Certificate Examination.

Students wishing to do the FCE should generally start their exam preparation course at least 12 weeks prior to the examination date.

Levels

All the Examination Courses are only available subject to a minimum number of 6 participants for each level. Students should begin their Cambridge course 12 weeks prior to the examination dates.

We cannot accept students for any examination course until we have confirmed that they are at an appropriate level to join the class.

Textbooks

Students can purchase textbooks from the school or from recommended bookstores in the city centre. Textbooks cost approximately €50.
