# English Language and Irish Culture

This course blends English language development with an exploration of Irish culture. Perfect for learners with at least an A2 level of English, it aims to boost communication skills while exploring aspects of Ireland's rich heritage.

Mornings focus on building essential language skills – speaking, listening, reading, and writing – in an engaging classroom. Afternoons offer the opportunity to discover more about Irish culture, with one afternoon module focusing on Irish Culture and access to our social and cultural programme on other afternoons.

# Enhanced English for Professionals

The Enhanced English for Professionals course combines English language development with essential professional skills. Core morning sessions focus on developing general English proficiency, enabling you to communicate more effectively and confidently. On one afternoon participants can access a module focusing on English for the workplace, including professional modules covering topics such as presentations and interview techniques. Participants also enjoy a city orientation. This course delivers a comprehensive mix of language learning and career-focused communication.

- Improve English language proficiency for everyday and professional contexts.
- Develop essential workplace communication skills.
- Gain confidence in professional interactions through targeted learning.

# English and Intercultural Communication

The English & Intercultural Communication course combines robust English language learning with the opportunity to explore Irish culture and heritage. Participants will participate in our afternoon social and cultural programme which includes some guided tours and engaging on-campus activities. Participants also enjoy a full-day Saturday heritage expedition to iconic sites such as Kilkenny's historic city and the Glendalough Monastic settlement.\*

# English Language Development

The Language Development course develops the language skills needed for social interactions, professional settings, and travel, with a strong focus on real-world communication. Participants may also join Emerald's afternoon and evening social and cultural programme to practise their English in authentic settings.

# Lifelong Skills Pathway

Our Skills Pathway follows a general English foundation with a focus on skills needed to navigate everyday life and the professional sphere. The Skills Pathway is mediated via a task-based approach which may involve collaboration, applied communication and creative project work.

- Communicate effectively and confidently in a range of personal, professional, and intercultural contexts using appropriate language, tone, and strategies.
- Demonstrate enhanced collaboration, teamwork, and emotional intelligence through participation in task-based group projects and reflective activities.
- Critically engage with global, cultural, and environmental issues, showing awareness of diverse perspectives and applying this understanding in meaningful discussions and tasks.
- Apply digital tools and creative problem-solving strategies to complete project-based tasks, presentations, and real-world challenges.
- Reflect on personal learning goals and progress, identifying transferable skills for future academic, professional, or personal development.

By the end of the week, participants will have created adaptable lesson ideas, assessment approaches, and a clear set of personal guidelines for responsible AI use in teaching.

The workshops equip participants with a working knowledge of key CLIL concepts and a selection of practical activities suitable for both primary and secondary levels. Recognising the importance of a teacher's language proficiency in CLIL, the course also includes dedicated language-development classes every morning.

The focus is on practical strategies that support diverse learning needs, strengths, and preferences across subjects and educational settings.
